SERMONIC POINTS: #1 Royal

"Now when the *Queen of Sheba* heard of the fame of Solomon concerning the name of **THE LORD**, she cam to test him with hard questions."

I Kings 10:1

SERMONIC POINTS: #2 Ruler

"She came to Jerusalem with a *very great retinue*, with camels that bore spices, very much gold, and precious stones; and when she came to Solomon, she spoke with him about ALL that was in her heart."

I Kings 10:2

"So Solomon answered ALL her questions; there was nothing so difficult for the king that he could not explain it to her."

I Kings 10:3

SERMONIC POINTS: #3 Remembered

"And when the Queen of Sheba had seen all the wisdom of Solomon...there was no more spirit in her."
