**SERMONIC
POINT #1:**

LOOK

"Now there arose a new king over Egypt, who did not know Joseph. And he said..., '**Look**, the people...Israel *are* more and mightier than we; "

Exodus 1:8-9

"come, let us deal...with them, lest they multiply..., that they also join our enemies and fight against us, and *so* go up out of the land."

Exodus 1:10

SERMONIC
POINT #2:
LABOR

“Therefore they set taskmasters over them *to afflict them...*

And they built for Pharaoh supply cities, Pithom and Raamses.”

Exodus 1:11

“But the more they afflicted them, the more they multiplied and grew. And they were in dread of the children of Israel.”

Exodus 1:12

“So the Egyptians made the children of Israel *serve with rigor*. And they made their lives bitter with hard bondage...”

Exodus 1:13-14

“Then the king of Egypt spoke to the Hebrew midwives, of whom the name of one *was Shiphrah* and the name of the other *Puah*;

Exodus 1:15

“ ‘When you do the duties of a midwife for the Hebrew...if it *is* a son, then you shall kill him; but if it *is* a daughter, then she shall live.’ ”

Exodus 1:16

SERMONIC
POINT #3:
LOVE

“But the midwives feared God, *and did not do* as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the male children alive.”
Exodus 1:17

“So the king of Egypt called for the midwives and said to them, “Why have you done this thing, and saved the male children alive?”
Exodus 1:18

“...the Hebrew women *are* not like the Egyptian women; for they *are* lively and give birth before the midwives come to them.’ ”
Exodus 1:19

“Therefore ***GOD dealt well*** with the midwives, and the people multiplied and grew very mighty.”
Exodus 1:20

“And so it was, because the midwives ***feared GOD***, that He provided households for them.”
Exodus 1:21

“So Pharaoh
commanded..., ‘Every
son who is born you
shall cast into the river,
and every daughter you
shall save alive.’ ”
