POINT #1:

**JESUS CALLS
US TO 'MAKE
DISCIPLES' ...**

“Go therefore and make ***disciples*** of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.”
Matthew 28:19

“***teaching*** them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the ends of the age.”

SERMONIC
POINT #2:
WHO & WHAT
IS A “DISCIPLE?”

DISCIPLE:
GREEK WORD:
“matethes”
“mathano” – to learn
LATIN WORD:
“discipulus” – pupil,
learner, follower

DISCIPLE:
“...one who follows another with the purpose of learning as a pupil.”

DISCIPLE:
“The one we believe we follow.”
“Conviction will always produce action.”

SERMONIC
POINT #3:
WHO & WHAT
IS A "BELIVER?"

"But as many as received HIM, to them HE gave the right to become children of GOD, to those who *believe* in HIS name."

John 1:12

"This beginning of signs JESUS did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested HIS glory; and HIS disciples *believed* in HIM."

John 2:11

"For GOD so loved the world, that HE gave HIS only begotten SON, that whoever *believes* in HIM should not perish but have everlasting life."

John 3:16

"He who *believes* in the SON has everlasting life; and he who does not *believe*...shall not see life, but the wrath of GOD abides in him."

John 3:36

"And many of the Samaritans...*believed* in HIM because of the word of the woman who testified, '*HE told me all...I did.*'"

John 4:39

"...I say to you, he who hears MY WORD and **believes** in HIM who sent ME has everlasting life...but has passed from death into life."

John 5:24

"JESUS answered and said to them, 'This is the work of GOD, that you **believe** in HIM whom HE sent.' "

John 6:29

"And JESUS said to them, 'I AM the bread of life. He who comes to ME shall never hunger, and he who **believes** in ME shall never thirst."

John 6:35

"...this is the will of HIM who sent ME, that everyone who sees THE SON and **believes** in HIM may have everlasting life; and I will raise him..."

"He who **believes** in ME, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water."

"JESUS said 'I AM the resurrection...the life... who **believes** in ME, he shall live...whoever lives and believes in ME...never die. Do you believe this?' "
