## **SERMON POINT #1: WORSHIP GOD... ...IN MORNING**

"My voice YOU shall  
hear *in the morning*,  
O LORD;In the morning  
I will direct *it* to  
YOU,And I will look up."  
**Psalm 5:3**

"But I will sing of  
YOUR power;Yes, I will  
sing aloud  
of YOUR mercy  
*in the morning;*"  
**Psalm 59:16**

"But to YOU I have  
cried out, O LORD,and  
*in the morning*  
my prayer comes  
before YOU."  
**Psalm 88:13**

"*It is good to give thanks to THE LORD, And to sing praises to YOUR name, O MOST HIGH;*"  
**Psalm 92:1**

"To declare YOUR lovingkindness *in the morning*, And YOUR faithfulness every night,"  
**Psalm 92:2**

"Now *in the morning*, having risen a long while before daylight, HE went out and departed to a solitary place; and there HE prayed."

**POINT #3:**  
**WORSHIP GOD...**  
**...ALL THE TIME**

***all the day.***”

## **DAVID'S SONG OF THANKS- GIVING**

“So they brought the ark of GOD...in the midst of the tabernacle that David had erected for it.

Then they offered...offerings before GOD.”
