SERMONIC
POINT #1:
FACTIONS

“Now I *plead* with you...that you all speak the same thing, and *that* there be *no divisions* among you,...”

I Corinthians 1:10a

“...but *that* you be perfectly *joined together* in the same mind and in the same judgment.”

I Corinthians 1:10b

“Now I say this, that each of you says, “I am of *Paul*,” or “I am of *Apollos*,” or “I am of *Cephas*,” or “I am of *Christ*.”

I Corinthians 1:12

“*Is Christ divided?*
Was Paul crucified for you?
Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?”

I Corinthians 1:13

"I thank God that I baptized *none of you* except Crispus and Gaius, lest anyone should say that I had baptized in my own name."
I Corinthians.1:14-15

"For Christ did not send me to baptize, *but to preach* the gospel, not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of no effect."
I Corinthians.1:17

SERMONIC
POINT #2:
FOOLISHNESS

"For the message of the cross is *foolishness* to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the *power of God.*"
I Corinthians.1:18

"For it is written:
'*I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, And bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent.*' " *Ish.29:14*
I Corinthians.1:19

"Where *is* the wise?
Where *is* the scribe?
Where *is* the disputer of this age? Has not God made *foolish* the wisdom of this world?"
I Corinthians.1:20

“For since, in the wisdom of God, the world through wisdom did not know God,... ”
I Corinthians.1:21a

“...it pleased God through the *foolishness* of the message preached to save those who believe.”
I Corinthians.1:21b

“For Jews request a sign...Greeks seek after wisdom; *but we preach Christ crucified*, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks *foolishness*,”
I Corinthians.1:22-23

“but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God.”
I Corinthians.1:24

“Because the *foolishness* of God is wiser than men, and the *weakness* of God is stronger than men.”
I Corinthians.1:25

“For you see your calling, brethren, that *not many* wise according to the flesh, *not many* mighty, *not many* noble, *are called*.”
I Corinthians.1:26

But God has chosen the **foolish** things...to put to shame the wise, and...the **weak** things...to put to shame the things which are mighty;"

I Corinthians.1:27

and the **base** things...and the things which are **despised**...and the things which **are not**, to bring to nothing the things that are,"

I Corinthians.1:28

"that no flesh should glory in His presence."

"But of Him you are in Christ Jesus,"

"...who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption—"

"that, as it is written, 'He who glories, let him glory in the Lord.'"
