**DEFINITION:**

**"S.W.A.G."**  
over-confidence,  
bravado, charisma,  
etc...

"Now THE LORD  
said to Samuel...I am  
sending you to Jesse...I  
have provided...MYSELF  
a king among his sons."

**I Samuel 16:1**

"...invite Jesse...and  
I will show you what  
to do; you shall  
anoint for ME the  
one I name to you."

**I Samuel 16:3**

“But THE LORD said to Samuel, ‘Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature...”

**I Samuel 16:7a**

“For THE LORD does not see as man...for man looks at the outward...but THE LORD looks at the heart.”

**I Samuel 16:7b**

**SERMONIC**  
**POINT #1:**  
**SET ASIDE**

“And Samuel said to Jesse, ‘Are all the young men here?’ Then he (Jesse) said...”

**I Samuel 16:11a**

“ ‘There remains yet the youngest, and there he is, *keeping the sheep.*’ ”

**I Samuel 16:11b**

“And Samuel said to Jesse, ‘*Send and bring him. For we will not sit down till he comes here.*’”

**I Samuel 16:11c**

"...he was ruddy,  
with bright eyes, and  
good-looking...THE  
LORD said, `...anoint  
him...this is the one!'"

**I Samuel 16:12**

**SERMONIC**  
**POINT #3:**  
**ANOINTING**

"Then Samuel  
took...*oil and*  
*anointed* him...and  
the Spirit of THE  
LORD came upon  
David..."

**I Samuel 16:13**

"But the Spirit of  
THE LORD departed  
from Saul, and a  
distressing  
spirit...troubled  
him."

**I Samuel 16:14**

**SERMONIC**  
**POINT #2:**  
**WISDOM**

"And David arose  
and secretly cut  
off a corner of  
Saul's robe."

**I Samuel 24:4**

“And he said...‘THE LORD forbid...I should do this...to my master, THE LORD’s anointed...”  
**I Samuel 24:6**

“*So David restrained his servants... and did not allow them to rise against Saul...*”  
**I Samuel 24:7**

**SERMONIC**  
**POINT #4:**  
**GRACE**

“So David said to Nathan, ‘I have sinned against THE LORD.”  
**II Samuel 12:13a**

“And Nathan said to David, ‘THE LORD also has put away your sin; *you shall not die.*”
